#### Français

I will be reviewing the following for a couple of days:

- Sounds é/er/ez/ai
- Sight words beau, belle, autre, toujours, souvent, beaucoup, plusieurs, sa, ses, sont, son
- Reading strategy for <u>decoding</u> pay attention to the silent letters at the end of words

This week we will also be reviewing the following:

- Sounds è, ê, ë, ei, et, ai, est
- Sight words moi, du, des, quel, quelle, dans, besoin, regarde, peux, peut
- Reading strategy for <u>comprehension</u>- make connections with your experiences and what you know

This week I will also be completing assessments of your child's reading. If they are approaching or working below grade level expectations, I will be emailing you to let you know.

To be <u>MEETING</u> grade level expectations in reading for FIRST term, your child needs to be reading at levels <u>F-H</u>.

## **English Literacy**

We have been working our way through the list of high-frequency (sight) words that students needs to be able to read by the end of grade 3. We have also been working on the following word families: ack, all, an, ank, ash, ap, at, ell, est, ick, ill and ip.

### Math

This week I will be formally assessing students on their understanding of skip counting forwards and backwards by 3s, 4s, 5s, 10s, 100s and 25s with numbers and coins. Once assessments are completed, I will send them home with a sheet attached indicating whether they are working below, approaching or meeting grade level expectations:

N1 – I can say the number sequence forward and backward from 0 to 1000 by:

- 5s, 10s or 100s using any starting point
- 25s using starting points that are multiples of 25
- 3s using starting points that are multiples of 3 (to 100)
- 4s using starting points that are multiples of 4 (to 100)

Building Block A: I can extend a given skip counting sequence by 5s, 10s, or 100s, forward and backward, using any given starting point

Building Block B: I can extend a given skip counting sequence b 3s, forward and backward, starting at a given multiple of 3 (to 100)

Building Block c: I can extend a given skip counting sequence by 4s, forward and backward, starting at a given multiple of 4 (to 100)

Building Block D: I can extend a given skip counting sequence of 25s, forward and backward, starting at a given multiple of 25

Building Block F: I can determine the value of a given set of coins (nickels, dimes, quarters, loonies) by skip counting
