## Français

We will be working on the following sounds, sight words and reading strategies for the next three weeks:

- Sounds - ch, ou
- Sight words-autour, petit, petite, cet, cette, ans, être, ici, vieux, pour, gros, grosse, jeu, de, mange, manger, monsieur, maintenant, très, dix
-Reading strategy for comprehension- retell a part of the text before continuing to read - Reading strategy for decoding - look at the initial sound in a word


## Social Studies

We will continue working on using maps to locate our town, province and country. We will also be discussing other cities in our province, the other ten provinces and three territories in our country. Students will be assessed based on class participation during these discussions.

## English Literacy

We have been working on visualizing as a reading strategy. Students have been drawing pictures of what they picture/visualize during read alouds.

We will also be working on the following word families in reading: -in -ing -ink -ock -op

## Math

I am hoping to assess the students later this week (December $6^{\text {th }}-10^{\text {th }}$ ) on representing numbers to 1000. They will need to be able to write expressions, read/record numbers I have given them and draw more than one base ten picture to represent a 3-digit number. Students will also have the opportunity to stretch their thinking with more complicated tasks. Once these assessments are completed, I will send them home.

We will begin working on the meaning of place value with numbers to 1000 . Some of the concepts students will be learning will include:

- writing a number for a given base ten picture
- writing the value of a specific digit in a 3-digit number - writing a number represented by base ten blocks arranged in a non-conventional format

We will also continue working on mental math strategies using our doubles, near doubles and friends of 10 strategies.
