Français

This week we will be working on the following:

- Sounds - *ette*
- Sight words - *il y a, elle, elles, puis, combien, avoir, va, vais, plus, pourquoi, moins*
- Reading strategy (comprehension) - *reread the sentence or part of the text*

Cross-Curricular Block/Science

We have started working on our new inquiry question, *What Happens in Nature?* So far, we have learned about the animal kingdom, named local animals that we can find in nature and labelled a beaver in our science notebooks. Next, we will learn about changes animals go through during the seasons in our province.

English

We will be working on realistic fiction pieces in writing this term. These are seed stories (events or activities that have happened in our lives) that have a small made-up part in them.

Math

This week I will be assessing the students on estimating using 2-digit numbers with addition and subtraction problems. Students will need to be able to demonstrate how to use two different estimation strategies. Once assessments are completed, I will send them home with a sheet attached indicating whether they are *working below, approaching or meeting* grade level expectations.
