



- * Basic addition/subtractions facts to 18
- * 3-digit addition and subtraction up to 1000
- * Mental Math strategies

* Estimating 2-digit numbers (rounding to the next ten). For example, 43 - 19 can be rounded to 40 - 20 = 20

* Skip counting: by 2s, 5s and 10s using any starting point, by 3s using starting point that are multiples of 3, by 4s using starting point that are multiples of 4, by 25s using any starting point that are multiples of 25.

Having a strong foundation with these skills will help prepare your child for a great start to grade 4.
